

Children's Voices

. . . is the name of **the new FUUSE children's choir**, re-created Spring 2009!

During the current school year it has consisted of 12 children, ages 4 – 8, and several older children have created an offshoot choir that also participates in singing in the sanctuary. The Children's Voices Choirs embrace listening, cooperation, and the intention of expressing the joyful noise of our spirits together! Children are invited to sing regularly in the sanctuary on Sundays, and to recognize themselves as an integral part of our multi-generational community, where **all are heard, valued and welcomed**.

We have collected music from various sources including FUUSE' previous choirs' materials, collections of traditional songs and hymns sung in the UU tradition, recent suggestions and discoveries of UU friends, and the "Rise Up Singing" group singing songbook. **We sing songs about peace, love, joy, nature, justice, and our connections in friendship**. We are grateful to all who have contributed to help the new Children's Voices thrive at FUUSE this year!

The same **UU principles which guide** and nourish the whole congregation are used to guide us in our music making journey together:

- ❖ Every person is important
- ❖ All people should be treated fairly and with kindness and courtesy
- ❖ We should accept one another and be free to learn together as a team
- ❖ We should be free to search for what is true and meaningful
- ❖ Every person should have a voice in things that affect them
- ❖ We should use the skills we are developing to help build a peaceful, free, and fair world
- ❖ We should use the skills we are developing to help build a healthy world

This Spring, 2010, **rehearsals** will generally fall on the 1st and 3rd Sunday afternoons of each month, in **the Sanctuary, 4:00-5:00PM**. Sanctuary Sings will generally fall on the second Sunday of each month. Rehearsal format allows that parents may leave the building from 4:00-4:45 (after signing children in and leaving emergency contact information for facilitators), and all return by **4:45PM for “show-and-tell” time**, when the children can share new songs, parents can prepare to be involved with home practice of songs, and facilitators can answer questions and have valuable collaborating time with parents. **PLEASE SEE BELOW FOR DETAILED CALENDAR.**

Volunteer facilitators for the choir are Janis Tierney, Chris Chance, and Neal Zweig. Janis and Chris have enjoyed years of choral singing with the church and elsewhere, and Neal lends special creativity to instrumentation as a professional lead guitarist as well as being a regular music-maker at FUUSE. Janis has naturally adopted the role of musical director, and brings her wisdom as a professional teacher to the Choir as well. Janis’ grown children were raised within the church, and she was also Chair of the Child RE Committee at FUUSE when they were growing up. Janis has taken a special interest in organizing and helping with rehearsal of older children and youth interested in singing opportunities within our FUUSE community and sometimes participating in a special leadership role with the younger choir. Chris provides vocal direction, coaches on voice exercises, and assists with rhythmic movement opportunities during rehearsals and has emerged as the coordinator-through- email of the younger Children’s Voices group. As a practicing Psychologist, Chris is pleased to be a part of community building with the youngest members of our church, and hopes the joyful lessons learned in choir will have a lasting positive impact on all the singers. Chris and Neal are also parents of Sasha (age 6), who is expected to never miss a rehearsal!
